## Nothing Is Impossible

8-26-18

Luke 1:37 For nothing will be impossible with God.

The lessons learned in last weeks message "When God Moves" concerning John the Baptist could be repeated in this weeks message. As we read these Scriptures, we will see God move in a very similar way with this added promise "Nothing will be Impossible with God!"

Luke 1:26-33

<sup>26</sup> In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, <sup>27</sup> to a virgin betrothed (promised) to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David (prophesied in 2Sam.7:12-13). And the virgin's name was Mary. <sup>28</sup> And he came to her and said, "Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!" <sup>29</sup> But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. 30 And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus (This is unique and no precedent.). <sup>32</sup> He (Jesus) will be great and will be called **the Son of the Most High**. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father **David**, <sup>33</sup> and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever (promises to Abraham and Israel the people of God), and of his (Jesus) kingdom there will be no end (prophesied to David in 2Sam.7:12-13).

This move of God is literally going to change the world, but bless her heart, however Mary asks a very real and basic question.

Luke 1:34

And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?"

There is not a precedence for a virgin birth. Even though it was prophesied in Is.7:14, the event was never fully understood. Therefore Gabriel is not upset by Mary's question, and gives her an answer that in itself is very difficult to comprehend.

Luke 1:35

And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God."

Our study is "Luke; Jesus and the Holy Spirit." Here we see them identified. But in reality we see the Holy Trinity identified: The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit! When God moves all the power of heaven moves! The supernatural Creator God is moving to bring redemption to man and ultimately transform the earth in which we live. With this great revelation, Gabriel who stands in the very presence of God makes a statement to Mary that gives every Christian hope, security, and confidence in their own crazy life here and now!

Luke 1:37

For nothing will be impossible with God [nothing].

The last word is this sentence is "nothing" which is left off most Bible translations. "Nothing" means literally "no rhema". Rhema means specific word, thus "no rhema" means "no specific word" from God to you is impossible. Literally - For "no specific word" shall be impossible with God "not any specific word". The Amplified version of the Bible actually captures quite nicely the double emphasis.

Luke 1:37 (AMP)

For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* **no word from God** shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment.

## In the OT Jeremiah also makes the point nicely!

Jeremiah 32:27

See, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh; is anything too hard for me?

## Even in the OT we see that God desires us to come to HIM with confidence knowing that nothing is impossible with God!

Jeremiah 33:2–3

<sup>2</sup> Thus says the LORD who made the earth, the LORD who formed it to establish it—the LORD is his name: <sup>3</sup> Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

## Mary reveals the attitude that God desires us to have so HE may do the impossible!

Luke 1:38

And **Mary said**, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; **let it be to me according to your word**."

The Apostle John reveals the attitude that God desires for God to do the impossible! Here is a specific Word to us from God.

1 John 5:14-15

<sup>14</sup> And **this is the boldness we have in him,** that if we ask anything according to his will, **he hears us.** <sup>15</sup> And if we know that **he hears us** in whatever we ask, **we know that we have obtained the requests made of him.** 

We rejoice because we are forgiven and qualified for better promises! For nothing will be impossible with God [nothing].

2Cor.5:21

God made him who had no sin to be sin, so that we might be the righteousness of God.
